

# The Veil Prevents Us From Accessing The Truth



At times we try and reach out to many with the gospel of truth, and as evident as it might seem, they might miss it. The main reason for this is that many people have been veiled from seeing the truth.

Reading Genesis 3:1-8 and Matthew 4:1-11 reveals the tragic impact of being "robbed" of the truth. The enemy tries to influence us with lies so that we ignore or doubt the word of God. The way to guard truth is to continue to increase your knowledge of your identity and include meditation and prayer as part of your lifestyle.

A veil's main role is to cover, therefore stopping one from seeing; it prevents access. Most of the time, things happening in our lives seem restricted to the seen world, but reality goes beyond that and starts from the unseen. It doesn't begin in the physical realm but begins in the spiritual realm.

A veil can be placed on the heart, on the mind and your eyes. These are vital tools that create a paradigm through which we see the world and live our lives. And if these tools don't recognize truth, then one's life may be built off lies.

The eyes are veiled through deception. The mind is veiled through ignorance, and the heart is veiled through unbelief. It is one of the most powerful tools the devil uses to deceive children of God (Revelation 12:9). The enemy will use the chaos in your life to make you doubt the promises God told you about your life. As a Christian, you need to know the word and speak out against lies

from the devil. Whatever you see that is not from God or His promises, you must rebuke it. Deception takes advantage of the ignorant. You need to know your identity as a child of God for you to take a stand. You need to impose the reality because you've been appointed by God to do so.

If you want to access another level with God, you must be humble to accept what the Spirit says; and Spirit says: Jesus is the truth. The more you know Him, the more you know the truth. Knowledge is light. The truth sets you free from deception, ignorance and unbelief.
